

## **CNTV** participates in a public hearing

## to debate Special Retirement

The Labor Committee of the Chamber of Deputies held a public hearing on Wednesday (25) to debate a proposal that deals with the granting of special retirement to those insured under the General Social Security Regime.

The request to hold the hearing was presented by deputy Geovania de Sá (PSDB-SC). She is the rapporteur on the committee of Complementary Bill 42/23, by deputy Alberto Fraga (PL-DF), which establishes different criteria for the retirement of people who carry out activities under exposure to chemical, physical and biological agents harmful to health.

"Special retirement is a topic of great relevance to society, as the insured person who is entitled to the benefit mentioned above is exposed to risks that are harmful to their health during long years of their working life", explained the deputy. "The topic under regulation must have a more in-depth debate, thus allowing greater knowledge and security in the construction of such a relevant standard", he added.

In his presentation, the President of the National Confederation of Security Guards – CNTV, José Boaventura Santos, highlighted important points such as the issue of intermittent and hourly workers: "There is an absurd situation that needs to be corrected because in the Labor Reform carried out by Temer, the figure of the hourly security guard and the intermittent security guard and the text of the bill as it stands, expressly states that this working time counts for nothing, so why was this type of work created, without any type of guarantee and very less right to retirement?"

Another important point highlighted by the representative of the security guards is the summary of the anguish of the security guards: "The security guard starts working at the age of 21 and with 25 years of service, in theory, he could retire, but this is not the reality we have, Furthermore, security guards over 50 years old are excluded from the job market, no one hires them after this age, therefore, the text with the age limitation as it stands will prevent special retirement, there will be no possibility of special retirement for security guards, the most we will get will be disability retirement since our work is painful and takes away our health. Therefore, if the text is not changed, we will be doomed to not enjoy in a dignified way what we spent our entire lives working to achieve."

The explanations had very relevant content to understand what this project is about and what the workers, not only the security guards, but everyone who this retirement could reach want. So those who want to see its content in its entirety can access CNTV's Instagram: @cntv.vigilantes.

It was gratifying for us, at CNTV, to be recognized and recorded on the Federal Chamber's channels in several speeches that today are still only discussing the issue of special retirement in Brazil for security



guards and all other categories of workers, thanks to the agreement reached by CNTV, deputy Chico Vigilante, Senator Paim and other parliamentarians, by the unions and fighting federations, affiliated to this confederation who truly cared about the vigilantes, didn't stand around blah, blah, blah and went to fight.


Now we need even more of the determination we had back then, the unity and effort of unions, federations, CNTV and all workers, demanding this right from the government, which is more than fair.
